Membership fees 2018-19 The IOPTMH received membership fees for the years 2018 and 2019 from 18 Members.

- In total, 14 Members paid full fees of 375 € per year (750 € for 2 years), and 4 paid reduced fees of 125 € per year (250 € for 2 years).
- Three members did not pay fees for the years 2018 and 2019.
